Founded in 1982, the Washington Regional Alcohol Program (WRAP) is an award-winning public-private coalition dedicated to fighting underage drinking and impaired driving in the Washington-metropolitan area.

Each year, WRAP partners with local law enforcement in addressing thousands of Washington-metropolitan area high school and college students with its *Alcohol Awareness for Students* presentation. **Offered in distinct 45 minute sessions for high school students and for college audiences—this program is designed to be individually unique to each school setting.** Thus far, the response has been extraordinarily positive and the demand ever increasing.



Program Highlights

Through the use of cutting edge information and ideas, WRAP provides an innovative and educational one-hour program designed to raise teen awareness of the dangers and consequences of underage drinking.
